



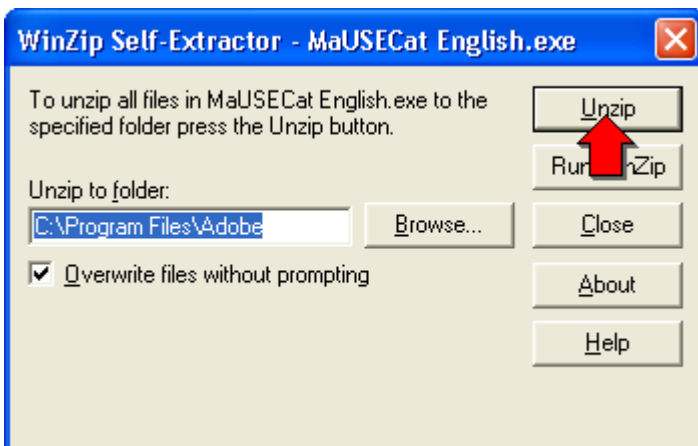
Marquette University Spanish English Catalog (MaUSECat)

Instructions for Installing MaUSECat

You should install and configure the Adobe Photoshop Elements program *before* you install the MaUSECat files on your computer. See the help file entitled “Instructions for Configuring Adobe Photoshop Elements 6” or “Instructions for Configuring Adobe Photoshop Elements 7” to learn how to do this.

Insert the MaUSECat DVD disk into your computer’s drive. Open the disk to view its contents. There are five files on the disk:

- MaUSECat English.exe
- MaUSECat Spanish.exe
- Sample MaUSECat Creations.exe
- List of English pictures, videos, and music in MaUSECat.pdf
- List of Spanish pictures, videos, and music in MaUSECat.pdf



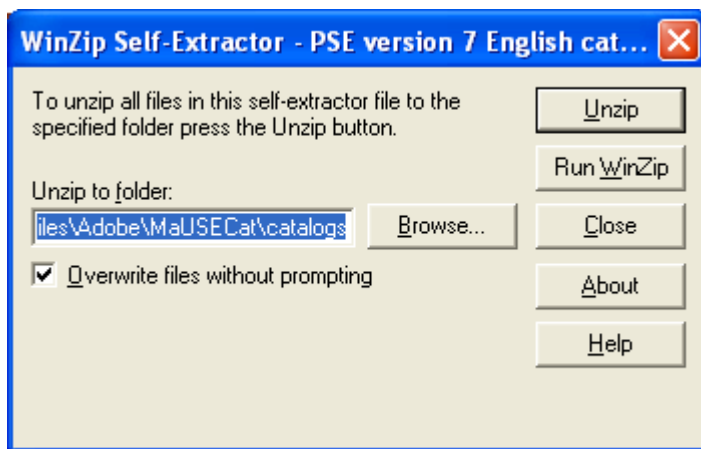
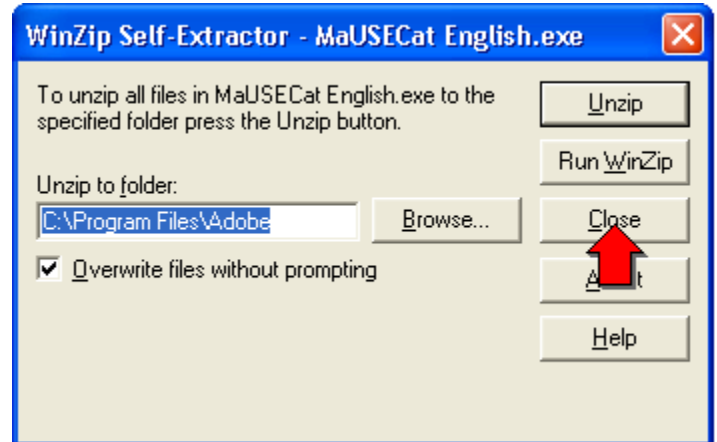
To install the English catalogs on your computer double click the file *MaUSECat English.exe*. Be patient. Depending on your computer system, it may take up to two minutes for the program to load. When it does click on the *Unzip* button.

On the screen you will see the progress as files are installed to the folder C:\Program Files\Adobe\MaUSECat.

When the program stops, click the *Close* button.

To install the Spanish catalogs, repeat the steps above with the file MaUSECat Spanish.exe.

To install examples of creations that can be made with MaUSECat, repeat the steps above with the file Sample MaUSECat Creations.exe.



If you are using version 7 of Adobe Photoshop Elements you must, as a final step, download and run the catalog updates. These are available at:

When you run these updates simply click the *Unzip* button, then the *Close* button.
